 - Become familiar with the organizing framework: focus areas, change concepts, and change ideas.
 - Review the flow charts in Appendix A to understand the cancer screening process that patients follow and the opportunities to improve screening.
- Determine if a needs assessment would help identify focus areas, change concepts, and change ideas that would be most effective and feasible in the health care facility or community of focus.
- Use tools and resources in the Social Determinants of Health focus area to help inform Comprehensive Cancer Control Plans.
- Encourage medical and other health professionals to use the [Cancer Screening Change Packages](#) to help improve cancer screening quality improvement metrics.
